M. 5, Vl. 2, note 1 is d" in source.

M. 46, Vc., n. 3 is g in source.

M. 49, Org., figure 8 is over n. 1 (along with figure 9) in source.

M. 50, Vl. 1, n. 3 has cautionary flat (= natural).

Mm. 77-8, Org., tie between n. 4 of m. 77 and n. 1 of m. 78 misplaced over n. 2 of latter measure.

M. 82 Org., extraneous 6 fig. over flat 6 fig. on n. 1.

M. 83, Org., n. 1, 6 over flat 5 in source. Should be over n. 2.

M. 84, Vl. 2, n. 1 is quarter in source.

M. 92, Org., upper figure over n. 1 is unclear in source.
